Discovery

Lisbon. Walk in the footsteps of famous explorers, and visit the Hieronymites Monastery and the Tower of Belém. See many other highlights, including Alfama, Lisbon's oldest neighborhood; Graça, a traditional neighborhood at the highest point of the city; and Rossio and Black Horse squares.

Óbidos. Visit one of Portugal's most beautiful towns, where the architecture seamlessly blends styles from the Middle Ages onwards. Sitting atop a coastal hill, this location was settled millennia ago for its strategic location.

Coimbra. While exploring the first Portuguese capital, visit the University of Coimbra and see the famous library, St. Michael's Chapel and a ceremonial hall.

Vila Real. Discover the extravagant Manor Solar de Mateus, an 18th-century baroque palace. Take a guided tour through the house and gardens. Then, walk along the cobbled lanes of Vila Real, stopping to taste a local pastry.

Porto's Wine Road. Drive through the scenic Alto Douro Wine Region. Not only is this area known for its vineyards, it is famous for its bountiful olive and almond groves. Visit the town of São João da Pesqueira, and stop at a *quinta*, a local winery, for a tasting of port.

Lamego. Sitting in the heart of the port-producing Douro Valley, Lamego is one of the country's prettiest towns. Visit Nossa Senhora dos Remedios, a baroque church overlooking the city. Leading up to the church is a grand granite staircase adorned with azulejos, Portugal's iconic blue-and-white tiles.
